IDE announces postponement of International Diamond Week

Ramat Gan, Israel- August 25, 2014: The Israel Diamond Exchange announced today it is postponing the summer edition of the Israel Diamond Week, originally scheduled for September 1-4. The exchange quoted the continuing tensions in the region as the chief reason for the postponement.
